Best case Federal support programmes



Federal support programmes of the 9 Austrian provinces

- Supporting energy audits in SMEs •
- Voluntary basis with financial incentives ۲ for the audit/consulting services
- Subsidised audits have to be done by qualified auditor
- Different in financial incentives and detailed programmes

klimaaktiv programme for energy efficient SMEs



Example of policy Programme for energy efficiency in SMEs in Austria

- klimaaktiv is the climate protection initiative set up by the Austrian Federal Ministry of Climate Action
- The programme klimaaktiv Energieeffiziente Betriebe is addressing energy efficient companies by following the transition cycle



Representatives from the federal support programmes, from klimaaktiv and from the Ministry of Climate Protection meet ~2x/year to discuss and evaluate the programmes and to identify need for adaption

Article 8 EED implementation in Austria: Energy Efficiency Act - Status



- Energy Efficiency Act is now under revision: Draft law not published yet
- Government program 2020 2024: Expanding the energy audit obligation to further companies

§9 Energy Efficiency Act

Audit obligation for non-SMEs: External energy audit / management system with internal energy audit

Energy audits for SMEs are recommended by the Austrian EE law:

- National support schemes motivate SMEs to undergo energy audits = federal support programmes
- Only companies who are not under energy audit obligation of the energy efficiency law can get subsidies under the federal support programmes

LEAP4SME Next steps - Interviews with the federal support programmes to discuss barriers and best cases

- How to address small and micro companies?
- Are there sufficiently well-qualified energy consultants?



- How to support the cooperation between the various experts (energy efficiency, renewable energy, resource efficiency, water, environment, Co2, etc.)?
- How to implement the *energy effciency first* principle in the audits?
- How to increase investments?
- How to lower administrative burden for SMEs?
- Etc.
