

What is the Covenant of Companies?

- A new pilot initiative led by the European Commission (DG Energy) to encourage and support companies to step up their contribution to a clean energy transition;
- Born out of contacts with the European Parliament (2019) & trade associations, research by JRC and Covenant of Mayors experiences;
- Provides practical, step-by-step guidelines and technical assistance to European companies to help them set and implement science-based targets resulting in the decarbonisation of their businesses;
- Recognises measures by companies with **'Seal of Approval'** awards.
- Duration: January 2022 December 2023





Why is it important?

- 24 million small and medium enterprises (SMEs) in the EU make up 99,8% of all EU businesses;
- The **fossil energy crisis** hit the competitiveness of SMEs;
- SMEs contribute to 64% of industrial pollution in Europe;
- 40-45% of SMEs are considered to have a large environmental impact;
- By supporting and recognising the efforts of companies big or small to induce bottom-up change, the Covenant of Companies will help us hit the 55% emissions reductions targets by 2030.





How will it achieve this?

PLEDGING AND RECOGNITION

- The initiative offers a pledging scheme with several levels of recognition (entry, bronze, silver and gold).
- The entry level of commitment looks at finding ways to trigger a company's awareness and understanding of which actions are crucial for business and planetary survival.
- Bronze, silver and gold encourage and support companies to take one or more concrete measures to reduce their GHG emissions.

ADVISORY SERVICES/TECHNICAL ASSISTANCE

- Provide practical advisory services to European companies to help them decarbonise.
- Two calls for technical assistance for companies: the first one in June 2022. The second from May 2023.
- Guidance documents and other useful <u>resources</u> available online, but also peer-to-peer learning and masterclasses.
- Encourage business investment in clean energy solutions/technologies to help improve business performance while mitigating climate change.

Company commits to take efforts to reduce emissions




